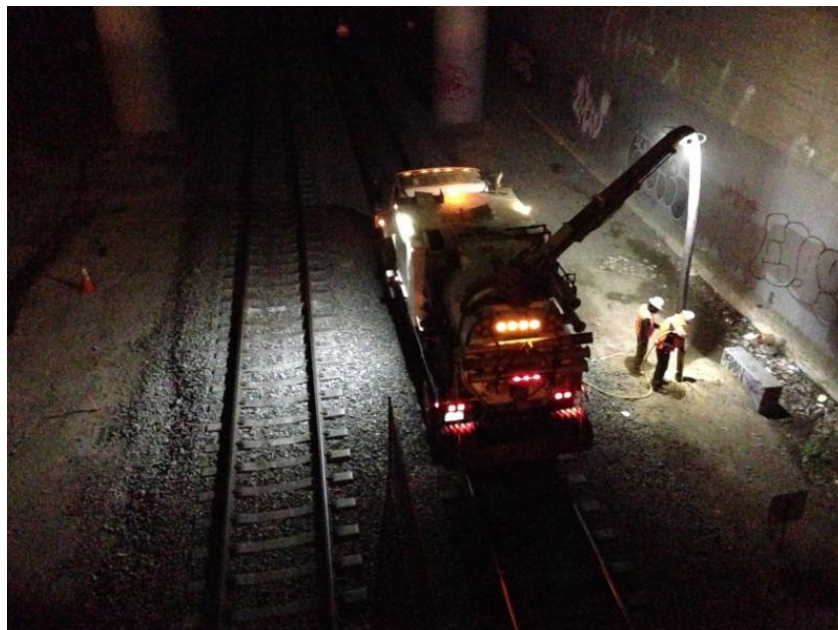
GETTING TRAINED - THE CAB CAR MOCK UP

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE



Construction to make Caltrain a modern, electric commuter rail system continues!
